Solution: All auto-sends seasonal reminders and upsell messages.

Tools: Sheets + Zapier **Difficulty:** Medium

4. Job Summary + Before/After Description Writer

Problem: Documenting work is time-consuming.

Solution: Al turns bullet notes into clean job summaries for invoices or social media.

Tools: Make/Zapier + Drive

Difficulty: Medium

5. Weekly Google Business Profile Post Generator

Al creates weekly posts about lawn tips, seasonal reminders, or project highlights.

Difficulty: Easy

6. Multi-Platform Content Repurposer

Turn one job (with photos) into multiple posts: Facebook, Instagram, GBP, Nextdoor.

Difficulty: Easy

7. Missed Call \rightarrow SMS Auto-Responder

Book more jobs by texting customers instantly when you miss their call.

Difficulty: Easy

8. Estimate Follow-Up Sequence

Al sends polite follow-ups to unsold quotes.

Difficulty: Medium

9. Daily/Weekly Schedule Digest

Al summarizes jobs, priorities, and route suggestions.

Difficulty: Easy

10. Customer Education Explainer

Al explains services like dethatching, aeration, mulching, or irrigation in simple language customers understand.

Difficulty: Easy

11. Safety / Weather Delay Notifications

Al writes quick updates when weather shifts the schedule.

Difficulty: Easy

3 — Example Automation Recipes (Mini Workflows)

These **5 workflows** are plug-and-play and designed for landscapers.

Workflow 1 — Instant Lead Auto-Reply (Lawn Care + Landscaping)

Trigger: New lead via form, SMS, Facebook lead, or missed call **Flow:**

- 1. Al reads the message
- 2. Al writes a reply asking for:
 - Address
 - Service type

- o Property size/description
- Preferred timing
- 3. Sends SMS/email
- 4. Logs lead

Prompt:

You are my friendly landscaping assistant.

A new lead sent this message:

Write a short reply asking for:
- Property address
- Service type (lawn mowing, clean-up, landscaping, irrigation, etc.)

Workflow 2 — Estimate Builder / Quote Translator

Trigger: You enter rough notes into a sheet **Flow:**

- Al rewrites them into a professional estimate description
- Sends to email/SMS

Prompt:

Rewrite this landscaping estimate in clear, friendly language: {{notes}}
```

Explain:

- What work will be done
- How long it will take
- What materials or equipment are included
- Anything the customer should know

Keep it 3-6 sentences.

Workflow 3 — Seasonal Services Reminder System

Trigger: At the start of each season or month **Flow:**

- Al generates seasonal reminders
- Sends to your email list or SMS
- Optional: includes upsell suggestions

Prompt:

Include:

Workflow 4 — Job Summary + Before/After Description Writer

Trigger: You upload photos or job notes

Flow:

- Al writes a before/after description
- Saves to Google Sheet / CRM / social folder

Prompt:

```

Notes:

Write:

- A simple explanation of the property's condition before
- What work was completed
- The final result
- Any future recommendations

Keep under 150 words.

Workflow 5 — Weekly GBP Post

Trigger: Weekly schedule

Flow:

- Al writes a local, seasonal landscaping post
- Emails you the final version

Prompt:

Write a weekly Google Business Profile post for my landscaping business.

4 — Landscaper Prompt Library

"Write a friendly message explaining a weather delay for landscaping services."

9. Review Request

10. Maintenance Reminder

"Write a reminder to the customer about upcoming recommended maintenance: {{service}}"

5 — Mini Case Studies

Case Study 1 — More Booked Jobs Through Instant Replies

A landscaper who often missed calls during mowing added an AI auto-responder. Customers received a text within seconds asking for address, service type, and photos. Lead-to-job conversion increased by **40**%.
